The second is that we do not have enough members who want to hold leadership positions to keep the organization going. I hope you will all continue to be involved with other programs and donate to The Salvation Army in the coming years. We will be having our last general meeting in June with a potluck social on June 5th. Thank you for your dedication to our organization and all your hard work and friendship. 


